



Learning Support Assistant/ Special Needs Assistant – SP3

JOB PURPOSE

To support a specific pupil's in their learning by:

- Actively engaging in child's play, scaffolding learning and helping them to extend their ideas.
- Working within a class, small group of children, or 1:1 and take some responsibility for their pastoral care.
- Implementing strategies identified in SEND paperwork
- Motivating and encouraging all children in the environment
- Use strategies to support child's listening and attention in the learning environment
- Clarifying and explaining directions
- Providing and preparing appropriate equipment and resources
- Raising children's self-esteem
- Implementing specific support plans related to the child

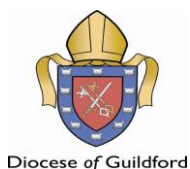
RESPONSIBLE TO

- Head Teacher, Class Teacher, School Business Manager

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

General

- To work as part of a team to ensure that the well-being, behaviour and personal development of children enhances their learning opportunities, life skills and promote the school's Christian vision and values
- To work alongside the class teacher and other support staff as a member of the class team
- Maintain confidentiality inside and outside of school
- Understand and apply school policies
- To assist with the delivery of the curriculum and activities as planned by the class teacher, and to use own initiative to extend activities appropriately
- To contribute to school planning and assessment documentation
- To liaise with parents/carers in consultation with class teachers or senior leaders
- To liaise with support services and outside agencies concerning individual and groups of children as required
- To be aware of and assist with the planning to meet the individual needs of child
- **To work within the school's safeguarding and child protection policies and be responsible for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of all children**
- To help to maintain a stimulating and safe class environment for children to learn in
- When necessary to work flexibly across the school in the best interests of the children as deemed necessary by the Senior Leadership Team





Liaison with Class Teacher

- Work closely with the class teacher on day to day planning for an individual pupil
- Be aware of and support the writing of pupil's ISP targets
- Be involved in delivering differentiated activities for a pupil with identified special needs
- Report to the class teacher on the learning during activities carried out and provide written observations/notes where appropriate or when requested

Classroom

- Be proactive in tidying of classroom and communal areas e.g. library, Hall
- Make necessary adjustments to classroom layout for activities to be carried out
- Prepare resources for activities
- Prepare equipment for children and classroom and outdoor learning environment

The post holder may reasonably be expected to undertake other duties commensurate with the level of responsibility that may be allocated from time to time.

Note: This job profile is subject to review and amendment in consultation with the Head Teacher so that the role continues to develop in line with the needs of the school. The job profile is not a definitive list but includes the principal responsibilities of the post.
