Classroom Forest School

Forest school have been keeping cool by creating boats from natural materials. They have been real thinking pigs, devising clever ways of joining resources together and persevering when changes needed to be made to keep the boats afloat!



The children have continued to practise their knot tying skills, both as part of their boat making and when helping to put up our climbing ropes in the shade of the Hazel and sycamore tree. They are becoming experts at the clove hitch, the timber hitch and the round turn with two half hitches!



We also harvested our potato crop last week. The children have taken great care of the potatoes plants, watering them and weeding around them regularly. The plants produced a grand total of twenty one potatoes which were added to year ones delicious potato salads.
