This week, the children in Year 1 have truly demonstrated our value of the half term—Courage. They all took part in the Key Stage 1 Phonics Screening Check, a national assessment of phonics knowledge at the end of Year 1. We were incredibly impressed with how sensibly they approached the task and how hard they tried. Well done, Year 1!

Next week, as part of their learning, Year 1 will enjoy a visit from Godalming Museum to learn more about Gertrude Jekyll—a renowned British horticulturist, garden designer, craftswoman, photographer, writer, and artist.

Year 2 have also shown great courage and perseverance this week by taking on the optional KS1 SATs papers. We're proud of their positive attitude and determination.

This week, the children had their class group photos taken, and we even managed to gather the entire school on the field for a whole-school photo. It was a lovely way to capture memories as we celebrate the school's 175th anniversary.

We're excited to share that our school has been invited to take part in the "Bunting for Bramley" project—an initiative encouraging children, families, and staff to design colourful bunting that will be professionally printed and displayed around Bramley village as part of the Discover Bramley campaign.
