# Classroom Focus

#### YEAR 1

What a wonderful start to Year 1 we have had. The children have moved into the new spaces of both the classroom and our outside area with ease, adapting so well to the changes in routine. It was lovely to share news of this at the Meet the Teacher afternoon recently with so many of you.

The outside area, with our new reading corner, is proving such an exciting place to extend our learning. The 'stones' are being made into increasingly complex structures with lots of great imaginative language as the children design and adjust their constructions. Inside, the rug helps to create a lovely calm environment. Thanks go to the PTFA for the funding that has helped us to achieve this; we are very grateful.

The pattern of our days has changed a little, although mornings still include Drawing Club (when we dive deeply into a book), handwriting or phonics and Maths. In the afternoons, Forest School with Mrs Miles on Tuesdays is a highlight. The children have been looking closely at leaves and identifying trees which ties in with our science learning for this half term. Do test them on their knowledge whilst you are out for a walk! (check the email sent at the beginning of term so that your child brings Forest School clothing for the week of their session.) Fitness is the theme of our Wednesday PE sessions as we think about how exercise changes our heart and breathing rate and can even help us to feel better. We are enjoying Year 1 and our step up to take on new learning very much.
