Pre-school have enjoyed their outdoor learning this term. They have been exploring the environment and using natural resources to make a range of wonderful creations.



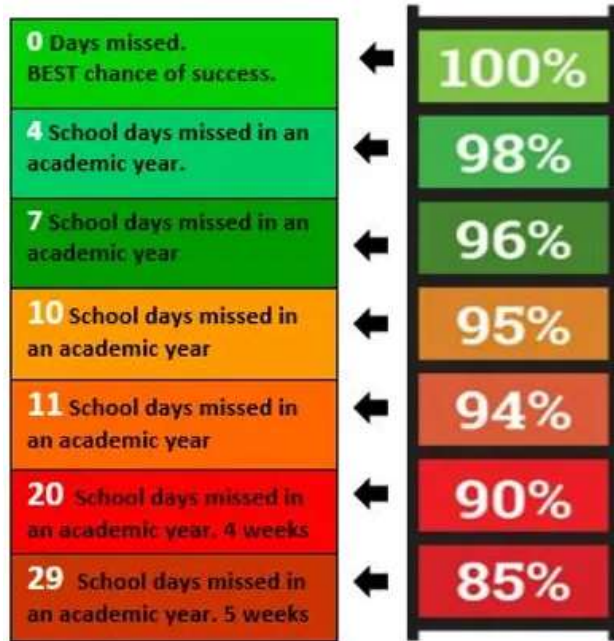
